WITH ACUTE BRONCHITIS

Members 18-64 years of age with a diagnosis of acute bronchitis **Common Chart** who were not dispensed an antibiotic prescription within 3 days of **Deficiencies:** diagnosis. NOTE: A higher rate indicates appropriate treatment of adults Data for this measure is with acute bronchitis (i.e., the proportion for whom antibiotics collected from claims only; were *not* prescribed). not through medical record review. \Rightarrow An outpatient or ED visit (that does <u>not</u> result in an inpatient admission) with a diagnosis of acute bronchitis Tips to Improve \Rightarrow Exclude members with a diagnosis of any of the following comorbid conditions: HEDIS rate: Emphysema • COPD Ensure proper coding of all Cystic Fibrosis diagnoses associated with a visit. • HIV • Malignant neoplasm
