1- Medical Care	Medical services to diagnose and/or treat a medical condition, illness, or injury	IP	Emergent medical inpatient admission
1 - Medical Care	Medical services to diagnose and/or treat a medical condition, illness, or injury	OP	Outpatient medical services (office visits for OON providers, in lab sleep studies)
2 - Surgical	Surgical services provided by a healthcare provider	IP	Elective surgical inpatient procedures and planned inpatient admissions (chemo administration)
2 - Surgical	Surgical services provided by a healthcare provider	OP	Elective surgical outpatient procedures; procedures done in office setting requiring an AUTH; in lab sleep studies
4 - Diagnostic X- Ray	Diagnostic x-ray provided by a healthcare provider	OP	Advanced imaging that does not go to Evolent (bone scans)
5 - Diagnostic Lab	Diagnostic lab provided by a healthcare provider	OP	Genetic testing (*routine labs do not require preauthorization)
6 - Radiation Therapy	Radiation therapy provided by a healthcare provider	OP	Radiation therapy for non-cancer diagnosis
12 - Durable Medical Equipment Purchased	Purchased equipment needed for medical reasons to be used by a person that is ill or injured and is ordered by a healthcare provider for use in the home.	OP	DME for purchase or convert to purchase
18 - Durable Medical Equipment Rental	Rental equipment needed for medical reasons to be used by a person that is ill or injured and is ordered by a healthcare provider for use in the home.	OP	DME for rental
42 - Home Health Care	Healthcare services rendered in the home by a healthcare provider	OP	Home Health care
56 - Medically	Ambulance, Ambulate or other Medical transport services	OP	Nonemergent transport requests

65 - Newborn Care	Management of the infant during the transition to extra uterine life and subsequent period of stabilization	IP	Sick baby or border baby requests
69 - Maternity	Services related to maternity care including related conditions resulting in childbirth when provided, or ordered and billed by a physician or nurse midwife	IP OP	Inpatient OB deliveries; OP Doula requests
70 - Transplants	Services related to the transfer of living organs or tissue from one body to another.	IP	Inpatient transplant admissions - planned
70 - Transplants	Services related to the transfer of living organs or tissue from one body to another.	OP	OP transplant evals and listing requests; mileage and lodging for transplant related services
76 - Dialysis	The process by which uric acid and urea are removed from circulating blood by means of a dialyzer	OP	Dialysis requests for OON providers
88 - Pharmacy	A licensed entity that dispenses prescription drugs and provides professional pharmacy services, such as clinical pharmacy consulting respective to the dispensing function. The entity may be a retail/chain or independent pharmacy or any other entity which dispenses prescription drugs.	OP	Medical drug requests
A9 - Rehabilitation	Services related to facilitate the process of recovery from injury, illness, or disease to as normal a condition as possible	IP	IPR or inpatient rehab requests
AD - Occupational Therapy	Professional and facility occupational therapy services performed by an occupational therapist, physician or other healthcare provider at a hospital, office or other covered facility.	OP	OT requests
AF - Speech Therapy	Professional and facility speech therapy services performed by a speech therapist, physician or other healthcare provider at a hospital, office or other covered facility.	OP	ST requests

AG - Skilled Nursing Care	Services for a patient in a skilled nursing facility for the purpose of receiving medical care or other health services.	IP	SNF or skilled nursing facility requests
BF - Pulmonary Rehabilitation	Services and instructional guidance administered to an individual suffering from respiratory disease in an attempt to improve the quality of life for the patient.	OP	Pulmonary Rehab
BG - Cardiac Rehabilitation	Services and instructional guidance rendered by a physician or other healthcare provider in a hospital or covered facility that are designed to help an individual recover from a cardiovascular event	OP	Cardiac Rehab
PT - Physical Therapy	Services and care related to evaluation and treatment of injury or disorders	OP	PT requests
TC - Transitional Care	Services related to the coordination and continuity of health care during a movement from one health care setting to another or to home.	IP	LTACH requests
