APPROPRIATE TESTING FOR CHILDREN WITH PHARYNGITIS

<u>Common Chart</u> <u>Deficiencies</u>:

 Data for this measure is <u>collected from claims only</u>; not through medical record review. Members -18 years of age, who were diagnosed with pharyngitis, dispensed an antibiotic and received a group A streptococcus (strep) test for the episode.

NOTE: A higher rate represents better performance (appropriate testing).

- ⇒ An outpatient or ER visit with a diagnosis of only **Pharyngitis**
- ⇒ Prescribed an <u>antibiotic</u> (Pharmacy fill date on or during the 3 days after the visit).
- ⇒ A group A streptococcus (<u>strep) test</u> in the 7 day period from 3 days prior to, through 3 days after ,the prescription date.

Tips to Improve HEDIS rate:

 Ensure proper coding: both of the diagnosis associated with a visit, and of the testing done.
