Specialists are permitted to perform all laboratory tests listed on the General In-Office Allowed Lab List, as well as the additional tests specified below for their respective specialties. All other laboratory testing must be sent to and performed by a participating reference laboratory.

Regardless of whether the test is performed in the specialist's office or collected and sent to a participating reference laboratory, the office may bill only one draw fee per patient encounter (CPT Code 36415 or 36416).

Claims submitted by a specialist for laboratory tests not included on either the General In-Office Allowed Lab List or the specialty-specific list below will be denied as non-allowed lab charges; the member will not be held financially responsible.
