The Sentara RMH School of Radiologic Technology (www.sentara.com/radiologicschool) offers the student an opportunity to develop an allied health career as well as gain valuable general educational instruction. The curriculum incorporates a combination of clinical and didactic learning experiences in a hospital setting.

The Sentara RMH School of Radiologic Technology was established in 1966 and is accredited by the Joint Review Committee on Education in Radiologic Technology (JRCERT). Graduates of the 21-month hospital based full time study program will earn a certificate and are eligible to take the national registry exam administered by the American Registry of Radiologic Technologists (ARRT). Prerequisite for admission to the Sentara RMH School of Radiologic Technology is an Associate's (or more advanced) degree in any field. By requiring a degree, the hope is to produce a well-rounded student with an avenue to advance professionally. The Sentara RMH School of Radiologic Technology is certified to operate in the State of Virginia by the State Council of Higher Education for Virginia (SCHEV).

The deadline for application, transcripts (all Colleges attended), and references is

December 1. An incomplete application will result in having to reapply the following year. The 21-month program will begin in August of each year.

Tuition at Sentara RMH School of Radiologic Technology will be increasing for the class beginning in August 2026 to \$2000.00 per semester(5 semesters) for a total of \$10,000.00 for the 21-month program. Most textbooks for the program will be available in the BRCC bookstore. The program application fee is \$25.00. Applications to the program will not be considered until the \$25.00 application fee is submitted. The application fee is non-refundable.

Sentara RMH does not offer financial assistance. Financial assistance is available for qualified applicants through colleges for courses taken there. Please contact the Financial Aid Department at those institutions for further information.
