Purpose:

This policy addresses the medical necessity of Near-infrared spectroscopy.

Description & Definitions:

Near-infrared spectroscopy studies, both contact and non-contact, exam wound using near-infrared light waves to identify if blood and oxygen are being supplied to the area.

Criteria:

Near-infrared spectroscopy is considered **not medically necessary** for any indication.

Medically necessary with criteria:

Coding	Description
58353	Endometrial ablation, thermal, without hysteroscopic guidance
58356	Endometrial cryoablation with ultrasonic guidance, including endometrial curettage, when performed
58563	Hysteroscopy, surgical; with endometrial ablation (eg, endometrial resection, electrosurgical ablation, thermoablation).
