# Dr. McCraw Reflects on Nightingale's 40th Anniversary as Both Surgeon and Patient

As a plastic surgeon specializing in traumatic injuries, John McCraw saw hundreds of patients flown into Sentara Norfolk General Hospital on the Nightingale Regional Air Ambulance during his 20 years of service at Sentara Norfolk General Hospital. When minutes matter, patients with crushed chests, mangled extremities, electrical burns, and facial injuries rely on rapid transport from accident scenes or outlying hospitals aboard Nightingale. When treating many of those critically ill patients, John never thought he would be a Nightingale patient himself.

"I woke up at 3:00 AM with the worst chest and back pain I'd ever had," John recalls. "I knew it was coming from my heart or aorta, so time was not on my side." His wife, Cynthia, called 911. James City County EMTs, firefighters and police were at their house within five minutes. "They established two intravenous lines, read the EKG, and called Sentara Williamsburg." Twenty minutes later, John was in the cardiac catheterization lab at Sentara Williamsburg Regional Medical Center.

Dr. Surgya Das, an interventional cardiologist and golfing partner, quickly determined that John's heart was barely functioning, with an ejection fraction of only 20%. He was dying. Dr. Das removed the blood clot from the heart vessel and inserted a stent in a matter of minutes. Nightingale was already waiting on the hospital's helipad, rotors turning, ready to fly John to Sentara Heart Hospital in Norfolk.

"I would not have survived an hour-long drive by ground," John believes. The flight to Sentara Heart Hospital took only fifteen minutes.

Coincidentally, the pilot that early morning was John's friend and neighbor, Scott Nance. In 2011, Scott gave John a tour of the current aircraft and showed him the sophisticated clinical equipment on board and told him how the critical care nurses and experienced paramedics on the flight crews were trained. John was astonished by their level of organization.

"The elapsed time from the 911 call and my arrival at Sentara Heart Hospital was less than an hour," John says. "That shows great planning and leadership, and perfect execution. Nightingale truly made the difference for me in making it or not making it."

John spent two weeks in the ICU at Sentara Heart Hospital, much of it intubated on a ventilator. "Spectacular" is the word he uses to describe the care team. "I've been in ICUs all over the country and have never seen such meticulous, coordinated, and thoughtful care."

John and Scott remain neighbors and friends. "Almost every time Scott comes down the street, he stops to talk. He knows how grateful I am," John says.

The McCraws donate to Nightingale every year through the Sentara Foundation. Their gifts are currently supporting a campaign to fund a replacement GPS guidance system, with state-of-the-art technology to assure safer instrument flying during poor visibility. The estimated cost of the new GPS is \$1 million.

### **Kay Morgan Stockwell Grand Lobby Dedication Event Honors an Extraordinary Life**

Kay Morgan Stockwell lived an extraordinary life. Kay was smart, hard-working, and tough when she needed to be. She was also unfailingly kind, humble, polite, and very funny.

In 2021, at the age of 54, Kay was diagnosed with glioblastoma (brain cancer). With no known cure for this cancer, Kay succumbed to the disease in September of last year.

To celebrate the incredible life of this mother, wife, lawyer, superb host and generous and loving friend, the lobby of the Sentara Brock Cancer Center was recently dedicated in her name.

On June 23rd, friends and cancer community supporters joined the Morgan and Stockwell families to unveil the signage that now adorns the wall across from the Cancer Center reception desk and dedicate the bright, airy lobby space in admiration of Kay, her life and her brave fight with her cancer.

The generous gift made in memory of Kay Morgan Stockwell will be used to fund the region's first multidisciplinary neuro-oncology clinic as well as expand upon the offerings needed to support a comprehensive neuro-oncology program.

The neuro-oncology multidisciplinary clinic strives to enhance the patient and caregiver experience by coordinated intake appointments, expedited treatment, and expanding integrative and supportive services. These services include clinical trial and research offerings, patient assistance programming, and lectureships to advance the knowledge of the local interdisciplinary team. # Carrillo Kern Center for Integrative Therapies Adds to a Comprehensive Approach to Treating Cancer

The new Sentara Brock Cancer Center, which now serves more than 700 patients daily, has transformed our community's cancer care. The Center itself is also constantly updating and transforming its comprehensive approach to treating cancer—body, mind and soul—even two years after its opening.

On June 8th, the Sentara Brock Cancer Center furthered its commitment to serving the whole patient with the dedication of the Carrillo Kern Center for Integrative Therapies.

Friends of Suzanne Carrillo Kern and Howard Kern joined them in dedicating the new Integrative Therapies Center and getting a first look at the space, which includes massage and treatment rooms with salt walls and a dedicated space for exercise, meditation, Tai Chi, and yoga classes. The couple decided to dedicate the Center for

Integrated Therapies to their siblings—Jeanne Carrillo Johnson and David Kern—who fought and lost their battle with cancer. "I have experienced first-hand how integrative therapies can support a patient's mind, body, and soul when undergoing cancer treatment. It is important for these services to be accessible and affordable to all cancer patients in Hampton Roads," said Suzanne Carrillo Kern.

Integrative therapy is an approach to wellness that combines traditional medicine with holistic treatments such as acupuncture, massage, nutrition, Reiki, art therapy, pet therapy, and more.

The Carrillo Kern Center for Integrative Therapies was designed and modeled after several of the country's most successful integrative therapy clinics and will be the first in the region to integrate a range of these services into a patient's care plan.

Patients are eligible for integrative therapy services from the time of cancer diagnosis through five-years post-treatment. Services are not limited to patients of the Sentara Brock Cancer Center; any cancer patient or survivor can visit the Carrillo Kern Center for Integrative Therapies. And some services are available for caregivers of active cancer patients as well as patients enrolled in Hospice services and their caregivers.

#### American Red Cross' New Community Emergency Vehicle



Leadership from Sentara Norfolk General Hospital and American Red Cross of Coastal Virginia gathered to celebrate the addition of the new Community Emergency Vehicle to the fleet.

There are few cargoes more precious than blood. The American Red Cross provides 100% of Virginia's blood supply. Their Community Emergency Vehicles (CEVs) are pivotal in driving blood on its complex journey from donors to patients. Sentara recognizes the Red Cross' lifesaving role in providing blood products.

"With this need in mind, the Sentara Foundation granted \$30,000 to the Red Cross' Coastal Virginia Chapter to purchase a new CEV," says David Proffitt, Director of the Sentara Foundation. "COVID-19 restrictions on large gatherings cut deeply into blood inventories over two years. Sentara Foundation donors generously provided enough to our COVID-19 Community Relief Fund to purchase the van to help quickly transport blood inventories."

Now that COVID-19 restrictions are easing and blood drives are resuming, this van will transport equipment and supplies to more than 1,700 blood drives each year at businesses and community groups in our region. It will deliver thousands of units of blood and blood products to hospitals and cancer centers throughout Coastal Virginia, including all Sentara Hospitals.

The Red Cross and Sentara co-branded this vehicle to demonstrate the vitality of the partnerships that significantly contribute to the quality of life in our region. Thank you for your contributions to meet this community need. ■





#### A Grateful Patient: Patricia Faison's Story

When you least expect it, a serious medical issue can pop up out of nowhere.

Just ask Patricia Faison. "I was picking flowers in my garden after work," the 60-year-old Navy veteran and avid cyclist recalls. "I felt fine, but a quiet, persistent voice told me I should go to the ER. I had a sense it was God speaking to me. I'd heard that voice before at key moments in my life, and I thought I'd better listen."

Concerned, Patricia drove herself to the hospital much to the astonishment of the admitting nurse and a few hours later was diagnosed with heart failure and a cardiac function of only 14%.

On day three in the hospital, Patricia received the formal diagnosis; Takotsubo Cardiomyopathy, also known as Broken Heart Syndrome, which can be caused by extreme stress. Patricia had plenty of that. She had been caring for many of her near and distant family members for years. She worked out regularly to stay in shape, but chronic stress has taken its toll on her heart.

To accommodate her dire condition, her doctors at Naval Medical Center Portsmouth suggested she transfer to Sentara. Things were going downhill quickly—shortness of breath, nausea, vomiting and a 'crazy' rapid heart rate. She remembers the back doors of the ambulance opening at the entrance to Sentara Heart Hospital, and little else.

"They put me on an ECMO machine," Patricia says. ECMO is short for Extracorporeal Membrane Oxygenation. The machine was pumping oxygenated blood to vital organs her failing heart could not reach. She remembers her niece Alicia, at her bedside with her care team, telling her she needed a heart

transplant and that, amazingly, there was a donor. She remembers feeling happy. Then, she woke with a new heart beating in her chest.

Recovery lasted "from Thanksgiving through Valentines' Day," Patricia recalls. There was speech therapy to help her swallow and restore her voice after removal of the ventilator tube. There were physical and occupational therapies to help her stand and walk again.

"Your team is awesome," Patricia says of Sentara Heart Hospital. "I have a military mindset and they're one of the smoothest running operations I've ever seen, kind of like the flight deck of an aircraft carrier. They are involved every step of the way. Every person, from the doctors and nurses to the people cleaning my room, treated me with dignity and respect—like I truly mattered."

Patricia also appreciates the heart coordinators assigned to follow her through the recovery process. "There are not enough words in the dictionary to describe the role heart coordinators play in your new life."

Almost a year after her transplant, Patricia is now focused on her recovery.

From her experience, Patricia decided to become a donor to the Sentara Foundation in support of heart programs as well as a donor to the Nightingale Regional Air Ambulance, which often flies critically ill heart patients, like she was, from outlying hospitals.

Contributions to the heart program and the Nightingale Regional Air Ambulance make a difference in lives such as Patricia's every day.
