A Grateful Nightingale Patient Reunion

Alice Talbot has no memory of the most important ride of her life. It was June 6th, 2003. She was unconscious, strapped to a stretcher aboard the Nightingale Regional Air Ambulance, speeding from Sentara Williamsburg Community Hospital to the Level I trauma center at Sentara Norfolk General, with no guarantee she would live to see the next day.

"I asked the ER doctor at Williamsburg if she would make it," Alice's husband, Bill, recalls. "He told me he'd seen it go both ways." Bill set off in his car for Norfolk, unsure if his wife would still be alive when he arrived.

Alice had been driving a pickup truck laden with bulk mulch for the Talbots' home in Charles City County. Alice doesn't recall what happened, but she crashed. The truck rolled over and buried her under the load. She broke her neck and suffered broken ribs, a collapsed lung, a ruptured spleen and a torn tendon in her right hand. First responders extracted her from the vehicle and transported her by ambulance to Sentara Williamsburg Community Hospital, where that team had already called Nightingale.

"I believe if Nightingale had not flown her to Norfolk, she would not have survived," Bill says. "It was a miracle."

Nineteen years after her life-altering crash, Alice had a tearful reunion with the Nightingale clinical team who flew her that fateful day on the helipad at the new Sentara Williamsburg Regional Medical Center.

Both the former hospital and the aircraft Alice flew on have been replaced, and the pilot retired. However, flight nurse Chris Cannon and flight paramedic John Tucker are still there, lending their vast experience to the stability and safety of the Nightingale program over the last 40 years.

"I always cry when I think about it," Alice says. "They saved my life."

Nightingale was just the beginning of Alice's long journey to recovery. She underwent surgeries and rehabilitation to walk and perform activities of daily living and return to a more normal life.


"The ICU (Intensive Care Unit) nursing care was phenomenal," Alice recalls. "If it had not been for Sentara, I would not have been able to return to work. These days, I can do everything I used to do except ride a bicycle." Alice was a teacher and has since retired, in her own time and on her own terms, to enjoy the rest of her life with her husband, Bill.

Alice and Bill wisely began planning what to do with their estate and programs to support philanthropy.

"The first thing we thought about was Nightingale," Alice says. The couple plans to leave a generous Legacy Gift to Nightingale through the Sentara Foundation Hampton Roads, and there is a reason for that. Nightingale operates at a fiscal deficit as part of the Sentara not-for-profit mission to improve health every day. They fly every critically ill and injured patient who needs them, regardless of their ability

Supporting Community Need

In August 2009, Heather and Demitri Wilson's firstborn daughter, Kennedy, was stillborn at Sentara Leigh Hospital after Heather suffered a placental abruption. Their grief was overwhelming and their time with Kennedy was short – brief visits in Heather's room as nurses brought the baby's body from the hospital's morgue, then took her back – precious snippets of time to bond before letting Kennedy go and having to plan her funeral.



These handmade "angel gowns" and tuxedos are made by a team of volunteers and given for free to grieving families around the world.

"There was nothing for her to wear," Heather recalls. "There were no burial gowns small enough." Amid her grief, Heather found inspiration. Over time, the Wilsons channeled their pain of loss into Kennedy's Angel Gowns. This home-based charity sews tiny girls' gowns and boys' onesies from donated wedding dresses, which are then gifted to families grieving their lost newborns.

At first, Heather made all the gowns herself. As word got around, demand overtook her time. Volunteer seamstresses joined her in solidarity. The charity now produces artistically decorated garments and ships them free overnight when hours count.

A Cancer Center Serving Our Community

Two years ago, at the height of the COVID-19 pandemic, the Sentara Brock Cancer Center opened its doors to support our regional community.

With careful planning and implementation, since that time the Cancer Center has added services and programs which now contribute to a thriving hub of activity, serving approximately 700-900 patients a day.

Walking through the Sentara Brock Cancer Center today, you will notice the meticulous attention to detail that ensures patients feel supported through their cancer journey. The only one of its kind in Southeastern Virginia, the Sentara Brock Cancer Center addresses cancer holistically. By bringing together specialists across disciplines, the Sentara Brock Cancer Center treats the whole person and stewards patients and their loved ones through the entire process and into survivorship.

One of the first things you notice as you enter the Cancer Center is the airiness of the spaces and the calming colors and features. The building design has the patient's health journey and customer experience as a top priority, including:

 A calming environment that features an outdoor Healing Garden which includes 300 commemorative bricks honoring loved ones who have endured the cancer journey and the caregivers who have supported them.



- Support services for advanced illnesses, including Sentara's first outpatient palliative care clinic in the Hampton Roads community.
- Integrative Therapies, such as massage, art, and music therapy.
- Silhouette Mastectomy Boutique A retail shop for wig services, headwear, and mastectomy products.
- Opening this Summer: Smoothie Stop, offering delicious and healthy smoothies, cold-pressed juices, grab-and-go wraps, and salads.
- A rehabilitation gym with two certified lymphedema therapists and fitness classes led by a certified cancer exercise specialist.

Created especially for the Sentara
Brock Cancer Center, an Art Committee
has contributed to the thoughtful
implementation of art throughout the
building, including a rotating donated
art program and permanent pieces
purchased from local artists. Soon to
be installed—an original mural on the
garage wall, sculptures in the Healing
Garden, and a signature sculpture for the
front of the building by California artists
Jennifer Madden and Jeffrey Reed.

Heather is an outreach manager for a local nonprofit. Demitri is a battalion chief with Suffolk Fire & Rescue. They had their hands full, managing inventory, shipping gowns, and raising their rainbow daughter Ryleigh, who blessed their lives just over a year later. But their too-brief time with Kennedy kept gnawing at them until they found a way to give other grieving parents more time with their babies.

The Wilsons began raising money - through an annual 5k run and their 'Angel Ball' event - to donate cooling devices to Sentara Family Maternity Centers through the Sentara Foundation Hampton Roads. The bassinet-style "cooling devices" of various designs gently circulate chilled air around babies' bodies, slowing decomposition and allowing families more time to bond before saying goodbye. The Wilsons also remembered there was no safe space for them to grieve away from the joyful hubbub of a hospital birthing center, and they decided to address that issue as well.

In August 2019, almost ten years after losing Kennedy, the Wilsons and eight-year-old Ryleigh dedicated The Butterfly Room at Sentara Norfolk General Hospital. The 12-by-10-foot space features muted colors, soft lighting, comfortable furniture, a softly flowing fountain, and a place for a cooling device, so families can privately visit with their lost babies as long as they need. Staff also use the space to decompress from the ups and downs of their work. "Heather and Demitri's organization has been a great inspiration to many of us. They took their pain and made it their passion. Today, the mission they serve through Kennedy's Angel Gowns is their purpose and all of us in Hampton Roads benefit from their philanthropic investment in the community," says David Proffitt, Director of Development & Community Engagement at the Sentara Foundation.

The Wilsons have also donated cooling devices to six Sentara hospitals and Naval Medical Center Portsmouth, Baby Memorial Walls at Sentara Leigh and Sentara Princess Anne Hospitals, and the Butterfly Room at Sentara Norfolk General – more than six figures worth of products and services. They continue to raise funds for replacement devices as earlier ones wear out and newer designs become available. There is always a need. Heather and Demitri Wilson have been meeting that need for more than five years through tireless volunteerism and boundless generosity to families in Hampton Roads and around the world.


