Options For Filtering Data


While reviewing information in DataPoint, you can filter the graphs to show only the data that you would like to see. Filtering can be used to highlight a portion of the data or to focus on a specific dimension.

Filtering Has Two Options

1. Basic: A user can filter data based on a singular dimension, such as descriptive values, conditions, and/or timeframe.



2. Advanced: A user can filter data based on multiple dimensions, using "and/or" tools, for a more concise record output.
